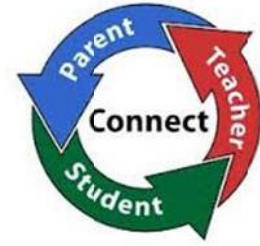


Parental Involvement
