ODOT continues road work in Ottawa County

DANBURY TOWNSHIP - Through August 2018, westbound Ohio 2 near Ohio 269 will be reduced to one lane, and the ramp from westbound Ohio 2 to northbound Ohio 269 (Exit 125) will be closed for slide repair.

Motorists are encouraged to use the northbound Ohio 53 detour, exit 124.

In November, Ohio Department of Transportation crews noticed a crack in the pavement of the shoulder and the road beginning to slope, causing unsafe travel conditions.

Additionally, lane restrictions are possible on Ohio 163, between Ohio 105 and Ohio 358, for finish work, according to the Ohio Department of Transportation.

As part of a different project, intermittent lane restrictions are possible district-wide through December for guardrail, striping and electrical maintenance.
