Last View from Fremont Middle School, 2012.

This photo was taken from the third floor of the Fremont Middle School on March 1, 2012, the last day the building was open to the public before it was torn down. The view is southwest across Garrison toward Park Avenue. A close inspection from left to right shows the 1853 Ralph Buckland house (left of the old Hayes Methodist steeple) at Park and Birchard, the rear of the 1850s Gusdorf house (below the steeple), the 1859 Fabing house (to the right of the newer white apartment building), and the 1924 Pontius-Daubel house across Park Avenue at the far right.
