Fremont Ross Class of 1969 starts alumni scholarship fund

FREMONT - The Fremont Ross Class of 1969 has started the Alumni and Friends Scholarship Fund for post high school graduation studies. The immediate goal is to raise \$10,000 to establish a fund with the Sandusky County Community Foundation (SCCF) a local non profit 501(C) 3 that helps organizations with administration and investing raised monies with the Croghan Colonial Bank Trust Department (CCB).

Current donations are at \$7817.50.

Once that goal is met, \$25,000 is needed to begin giving scholarships. The long-term goal is to raise as much money as possible to help as many students as possible. The SCCF allows 4% gifting per year for perpetuity reasons. The group will focus on under-served students at or below the poverty level, which is at 73%.
