1. John McCreery reviewed a 08 Design Manual Update (see attachment).
 - a. Roof considerations (color, slope) and classroom illumination were addressed.
 - (1) Classroom illumination – discussion on side lighting, clerestory windows (use this technique when possible to reduce operating costs, i.e. fewer lighting fixtures).
2. An Eco-Charrette exercise held recently covered the LEED checklist to determine which points the district would want to pursue on this project.
3. Classrooms organization designs from the last meeting's break-out sessions were reviewed. From these, John came up with his first design drawings. In his designs, he looked at configuration from a functional standpoint – not considering square footage.
 - a. Three computer lab's square footage was taken in to the Extended Learning Area square footage to allow for this space. Extended Learning Areas are not allocated space on the POR.
 - b. Although options are shown very quickly at this point, the team must be careful of making quick decisions. Some factors to consider:
 - (1) Access to the middle school from the high school.
 - (2) Traffic – a traffic flow study is in process
 - (3) Soils – stability
 - (4) Before and after school interaction between grades (avoidance of fights)
 - (5) Student drop-off
 - (6) Mechanical rooms and the efficiency to pipe

4. The team needs to discuss the merits of the various schemes and then look at deficiencies, adapting to make the design more desirable. Today's designs are the first pass at coming to the district's desire of what is wanted in a building.

5. Design Team will not meet next week. The next Design Team Meeting will be held on Thursday, March 26, 4:00 p.m., in Room #116.
