Agenda:

1. Extended Learning Space and building visits
2. Library / Media square footage
3. Art / Music square footage and music practice areas
4. Gymnasium w/auditorium versus cafetorium

Discussion:

1. There is no line item on the OSFC worksheet for the Extended Learning Area. Two options are available to allow for this space:
 - a. Use some corridor space square footage or use the current 960 SF under allowable (/3 would allow one per grade level).
 - b. Tony and Cheryl shared thoughts on Seneca East's Extended Learning Area. They would recommend windows in classroom doors to view the area and enough space for 2 tables with chairs.
2. Library / Media:
 - a. Janet recommends combining the office space with the workroom/storage space (370 SF).
 - b. Library: allow for computer space and the reading space needs to be large enough to accommodate 2 classrooms of students.
3. Gymnasium/Stage/Cafetorium. Two options discussed: add the overage SF (960) to stage size or eliminate cafetorium stage and add overage SF to gymnasium (see attachments).
 - a. Current OSFC allowable gymnasium: 8500 SF

- b. High school minimum court size: 84' x '50
 - c. Art to visit gymnasiums at Mansfield and Marion-Harding.
 - d. Concern: allot enough storage space and separate PE and athletic storage
 - e. Concern: current stage design not large enough; ample seating, acoustics, and lack of PE instruction time if gymnasium used for auditorium. More local discussions need to take place with arts (music) personnel involvement. Research largest performing arts group historically in the district and the potential audience size.
 - f. Recommendation: keep cafeteria and gymnasium in proximity; would allow these high traffic areas to be kept separate from rest of the building and allow for cafeteria to be used for concessions.
4. The next meeting will be held on Monday, January 26th at 8:30 a.m. Areas to be discussed at that time: Art, Music, Gymnasium, Stage, and Cafetorium
