Fremont school board approves summer programs

FREMONT -- The city's board of education approved several summer programs at Monday night's meeting.

- The summer migrant program for students in grades Pre-K through sixth, and will be held at Hayes Elementary School on weekdays Monday through Friday. The program begins June 22 and ends July 31.
- An elementary summer intervention will be held for students in grades first through fifth. This will be held at Atkinson Elementary from June 22 through July 24.
- Summer intervention for grades six through eight, which will be held at the middle school from June 22 to July 24.
- The Ohio Graduation Test summer camp for students in grades 9-12, beginning June 15 and ending June 19 from 8:30 to 11:30 a.m. at the high school.

Also approved are 10 calamity days on reserve at the end of the school years (2009-10 and 2010-11) if the district exceeds the five days allowed by the state for emergency closing.

The following math textbooks were also approved:

- Algebra 1 books and materials for a total of \$21,539.52, algebra II books and materials for a total of \$15,228, geometry books and materials for a total of \$30,753.80 and pre-calculus books for a total of \$6,301.02.
