Fremont schools offering summer school

Fremont City Schools will provide summer school services to students in the school district for six weeks beginning June 22.

Middle school students will be served at the Fremont Middle School while elementary school students will be at Atkinson Elementary School. The program will enroll first those students whose families are income eligible then those who are referred for academic reasons.

Summer school hours begin at 8:30 a.m. with breakfast for the students. They also will receive lunch and an afternoon snack before dismissal at 3 p.m. All students will receive academic instructions from licensed teachers in the mornings while afternoon sessions will consist of various activities conducted by community partners, as well as swimming and field trips. Transportation also is available for the students.

The program is funded by the 21st Century Community Learning Centers and is a partnership between the Fremont school district, the United Way of Sandusky County, and WSOS Community Action Commission, Inc. It is operated by WSOS throughout the school year and the summer.
