Students raise money for the Ronald McDonald House

Students at Vanguard Career Center have been collecting pop tabs for the Ronald McDonald House throughout the year.

This year's collection was tallied April 28. The students gathered 241.26 pounds of pop tabs. A grand total of 278.26 pounds of aluminum will be taken to the Ronald McDonald House Charities in Toledo.

The Medical Aide I students spearheaded the drive. Throughout the year, these students collected and stored the pop tabs from the various labs and classrooms. They were also responsible for calculating the final totals.

The welding lab collected the most pop tabs. They collected a grand total of 127.5 pounds of tabs.

They also designed a full scale large and small aluminum tabs that weighed an additional 37.5 pounds.
