Achievement fair showcases programs

COLUMBUS -- The Ohio School Boards Association Student Achievement Fair is a showcase of innovative programs Ohio public school districts have developed to promote exceptional student achievement.

The Student Achievement Fair at OSBA's 54th annual Capital Conference and Trade Show will highlight scores of outstanding initiatives created by school districts from across the state. The fair will be Nov. 10 in Columbus.

More than 10,000 school board members, administrators and guests are expected at the 2009 Capital Conference Nov. 8 through 11. In addition, nearly 700 exhibitors will display their goods and services at the Trade Show, the nation's largest education trade exhibition.

Topics to be featured in presentations and displays at the Student Achievement Fair include reading and math initiatives, energy conservation, performing and graphic arts, science, community service, living history, character building, business management, political studies, technology, career-technical projects, after-school programs and environmental education.

Clyde-Green Springs and Fremont City will both be represented at the fair.
