

Board approves eight teachers' retirements

FREMONT -- Eight long-time teachers in the Fremont district plan to retire June 1.

The school board approved the retirements Monday night.

Those who will retire are Brenda Bilal, Rhonda Damschroder, Susan Myers and Patricia Schulz from Stamm Elementary School. Fremont Middle School retirees are Linda Grayson and Dianne Kriechbaum. Charlene Logsdon will retire from Atkinson school and Janet Luse will retire from Ross High School.

All of the retiring teachers have 25 to 35 years of experience in the district.

"You'll see more retirements come in as the year continues," Superintendent Traci McCaudy told the board.

She said at the end of the school year, they'll have a get-together for the retiring teachers.

In other business, Eric Szymanowski and Greg Lauer approached the board on behalf of home-schooling parents, asking that home-schooled children be allowed to participate in the district's athletics and arts programs. Board President Tim Ellenberger said members will discuss the issue at April's policy committee meeting.
