Campbell leads Ross over Sandusky

Kori Campbell had 126 rushing yards as Fremont Ross's junior varsity football team beat Sandusky 24-19 victory Saturday at Don Paul Stadium.

Campbell scored from 2 yards out and TJ Harkness passed to Tre Rollins for the two-point conversion as Ross led 8-7 at the half.

Harkness threw for 92 yards and Rollins had four catches for 59 yards for Ross (2-1).

Campbell scored from 54 yards out and pulled in a two-point conversion pass from Harkness for a 24-7 advantage in the second half.

Rollins added a 27-yard touchdown catch from Harkness in the second half. Harkness ran in the two-point conversion.

Josiah Brittner, Michael Bell, Derrick McGhee and Campbell each had one sack for Ross. Jalil Dolton and Dylan Starks each recovered a fumble while Starks added an interception.

Rubin Robinson had 5.5 tackles, Dominic Parker four, and Jordan Garcia, Andres Alejandro and Bell each added 3.5 for Ross, which had eight tackles for a loss.
