Fall athletes finish seasons

FREMONT -- This story is the second installment in a series of reports on former Ottawa and Sandusky County high school athletes who have gone on to participate in sports at the college level.

The athletes featured in this story are golfers, soccer and volleyball players from the 2009 season.

VOLLEYBALL

- Amy Benz, Old Fort, Cleveland State University -- In 34 matches, Benz, a middle hitter, had 315 kills, 19 blocks and 383 points as the Vikings went 26-8.
- Sara Doebel, Clyde, Capital University -- In 31 matches, Doebel, a defensive specialist, had 551 digs as the Crusaders went 16-15.
- Amber Kuns, Margaretta, Otterbein College -- In 27 matches, Kuns, an outside hitter, had 20 kills, 11 blocks and 9 digs as the Cardinals went 24-9.
- Morgan Magers, Old Fort, Heidelberg University -- In 35 matches, Magers, a setter, had 1,372 assists, 91 kills, 304 digs, 39 blocks as the Student Princes went 27-8. She was named to the AVCA All-America second team.
- Leisha Salyer, Clyde, West Virginia State University -- In 18 matches, Salyer, a defensive specialist, 213 digs, 31 kills and 6 blocks as the Yellow Jackets went 16-12.
- Nicole Schoen, Bellevue, Baldwin-Wallace College -- In 22 matches, Schoen, an outside hitter, had 79 kills, 40 digs and 14 blocks. She missed significant time in 2009 because of an injury as the Yellow Jackets went 5-24.

GOLF

- Andrew Aseltine, Fremont Ross, Miami University -- Did not see action during the fall season.
- Victoria Aseltine, Fremont Ross, Cleveland State University -- Played 10 rounds with a 91.4 stroke average. Her low round was an 83 and she had one top 20 finish.
- Sarah Baker, Clyde, Heidelberg University -- Played seven rounds with a 94.7 stroke average. Her low round was a 91 and she had three top 15 finishes.
- Jordan Frank, SJCC, Lake Erie College -- Did not see action during the fall season.
- Phoenix Golnick, Oak Harbor, Defiance College -- Played 10 rounds with a 103.6 stroke average. Her low round was a 97.

- Craig Lamson, SJCC, Mount St. Joseph College -- Played 11 rounds with an 86.6 stroke average. His low round was an 81 and with his best finish being 19th at the Taylor Made/Adidas Collegiate Invitational.
- Jessica Lynch, Bettsville, University of Findlay -- Played four rounds with a 90.5 stroke average. Her low round was an 80.
