Findlay trounces Fremont Ross JV 54-6

FINDLAY -- The Fremont Ross junior varsity football team lost 54-6 to Findlay during a Greater Buckeye Conference game Saturday.

The Little Giants' offense sputtered against the Trojans' aggressive defense.

In the first half, quarterback T.J. Harkness completed 3-of-11 passes for 29 yards. He was replaced in the second half by Jordan Garcia, who was 2-of-6 for 62 yards and two interceptions.

Ross broke up the shutout in the fourth quarter when Andres Alejandro hauled in a 56-yard touchdown pass from Garcia on the Little Giants' last drive of the game.

The Trojans held Ross's rushing attack in check, allowing 23 yards on 30 carries. David Garza led the Little Giants with 22 yards on 13 running attempts. Keon Domanski added 11 yards on four carries.

In addition to Alejandro's TD grab, Tre Rollins made two catches for 25 yards and Heaven Fry had one reception for 12 yards.

Dominic Parker recorded six tackles and intercepted two passes for Ross. Donald Carter chipped in 6 1/2 tackles while Travis Maynard and Trevor Lull posted 5 tackles apiece.

The Little Giants are 3-2-1 overall and 0-1 versus the GBC.
