Fremont Ross to join Toledo City League

TOLEDO -- Fremont Ross has been accepted into the Toledo City League beginning with the 2011-2012 season.

The league's board of control met today to consider admitting Ross, Findlay and Lima Senior. Ross was the only school chosen.

Toledo City League Commissioner Ed Scrutchins referred media inquiries to Ross athletic director Art Bucci, who could not be reached for comment.

There are currently 10 co-ed schools in the City League, two all-boys Catholic schools and two all-girls Catholic schools.

The Greater Buckeye Conference currently has six teams, but Napoleon has announced its intentions to move to the Northern Lakes League into an opening created by Rossford's departure for the newly-formed Northern Buckeye Conference. Sandusky was invited to join the Northern Ohio League after the announced departure of Upper Sandusky and Galion.

Findlay, Lima and Ross each applied to the City League. The remaining member of the GBC, Marion Harding, mulled joining but decided against it.

With Ross's departure, the conference will be left with three teams -- Marion Harding, Findlay and Lima Senior -- starting in 2011.
