RB at head of Fremont Ross Hall of Fame class

Charles "Twinkle Toes" Glover lead the 21st induction class into the Fremont Ross Sports Hall of Fame.

Glover was one of six Little Giant athletes elected to the Hall by the Selection Committee on Tuesday night. Joining Glover will be John Lozano, Brad Bordon, Chris Benson, Jim Sherman and Westley Glover.

Charles Glover was a running back who averaged 9.2 yards per carry while leading the Little Giants to a fifth-place state ranking. He won six Ross letters: two each in football, basketball and track.

Lozano was a three-sport star. He won seven letters and helped his Little Giants football teams to a 25-5-1 record in three years. He was also a Buckeye Conference champion in wrestling.

Brad Bordon quarterbacked the Little Giant to a 9-1 record in 1973, winning state honors in both the Associated Press and United Press International team selections.

Defensive back Chris Benson is the single season record holder for interceptions, with 11 picks in 1990.

Jim Sherman will join his father, Dick, in the Hall of Fame. He won three letters in football and two in track where in won the 1976 district 100-yard dash in 9.9 seconds. He played in the "Big 33" football game in Hershey, Pa. after his senior year.

Westley Glover will be inducted posthumously. He was a first-team All-Ohio defensive lineman in 1956.

The induction ceremony will be in May.
