## Toledo City League will consider 3 GBC schools

Fremont Ross, Lima Senior and Findlay all seek entry

The Toledo City League will consider for membership all of the Greater Buckeye Conference schools that have applied.

The league's board of control met Tuesday and will study the applications made by Fremont Ross, Lima Senior and Findlay. There are currently 10 co-ed schools in the city league, two all-boys Catholic schools and two all-girls Catholic schools.

Ed Scrutchins, commissioner of the City League and athletic director for Toledo Public Schools, said no decision has been made on whether to accept one, two or all three schools that have applied. The board will consider the matter at next month's meeting on Oct. 13.

The Greater Buckeye Conference currently has six teams, but Napoleon has announced its intentions to move to the Northern Lakes League into an opening created by Rossford's departure for the newly-formed Northern Buckeye Conference. Sandusky was invited to join the Northern Ohio League after the announced departure of Upper Sandusky and Galion.

Findlay, Lima and Ross each applied to the City League. The remaining member of the GBC, Marion Harding, mulled joining but decided against it.
