Dear Parents/Guardians,

As of today, Fremont City Schools has been closed five days due to inclement weather. Our Board of Education allows us to use five calamity days without penalty and the utilization of “blizzard bags” for an additional three days.

If we close school for another day, students will be required to “make up” their school day assignments via blizzard bags. Within ten days of the calamity day, teachers will send home very thoughtful assignments, and students will have two weeks (including two weekends) to complete their graded assignments. Additional details/information will be provided with the blizzard bags.

If the District has more than eight calamity days, those days will need to be made up at the end of the school year as specified by the District’s 2017-2018 calendar.

Here’s hoping for good weather for the remainder of the year and an early spring!
