This contract outlines expectations for students, parents and the Fremont City School District. Because online learning represents a non-traditional learning experience, students will have standards that must be met in order for them to be successful. Students will need to actively participate and complete assignments and assessments in all scheduled courses. If students do not meet the requirements of each course or fail to comply with Fremont City Schools Code of Conduct and/or Acceptable Use Policy they will need to return to on-site classes.

Student Expectations

1. Adhere to the *Code of Conduct* and *Acceptable Use Policy* while participating in virtual learning.
2. Must complete all assignments, quizzes and tests by the assigned due date.
3. Understand that all grades will count toward your GPA and extracurricular eligibility.
4. Understand that grades will be recorded on your high school transcript and report card.
5. Understand that you will be required to report to school to complete required state testing.
6. Understand that students who are not successful in virtual learning, as determined by school administration, may have to return to in-person learning.
7. Understand that school communications, ie: Fremont City Schools' email and google classroom are expected to be checked daily for the purpose of successful completion of activities.

Parent Expectations

1. Ensure that the student has the necessary equipment and internet access.
2. Ensure that students complete their assignments by due dates.
3. Encourage students to ask for help from a teacher if needed.
4. Hold students responsible for completing their own work.
5. Understand that students will be required to report to school for state testing.
6. Understand that students who are not successful in virtual learning will return to in-person learning.
7. Understand that it is my responsibility to keep all communication information updated in Final Forms.

District Expectations

1. If a student has an active 504 Plan or IEP, the district will help determine if the accommodations and support can be delivered virtually or if they need to be modified.
2. Support will be available during scheduled hours (as communicated by the teacher) to provide academic assistance when needed.
3. When students select the option for virtual learning, they can later choose to come back to in-person learning, on a quarterly basis.
4. Students who choose virtual learning will be permitted to participate in extracurricular programs/activities/sports, pending eligibility requirements being met.
