I am excited to bring you information about Fremont Ross High School's graduation and the final requirements and/or obligations for our graduating senior. *Please note that students who owe fees will not be granted permission to participate in the graduation ceremony; also, official transcripts will not be released until all outstanding school fees have been paid.* They were given a copy of their fees today.

Graduation is about celebrating the closing of a major chapter in your child's life by acknowledging all of the hard work your child has completed in order to fulfill the requirements of Fremont Ross High School and the State of Ohio. In order to preserve the dignity of our graduation ceremony and ensure wonderful memories of this special event, we ask that you read and share the information on the back of this letter with your child and other guests. We are planning on streaming the graduation ceremony from Don Paul Stadium live on our district website. The graduation ceremony is on June 6, 2021 at 2:00 p.m. at Don Paul Stadium at Harmon Field. We will have designated handicapped parking area at the former Stamm School location. This area is available for handicapped family members on a first come, first serve basis. Keep in mind that all seats, including purple seats, at Don Paul Stadium are available for all guests. There is **no reserved seating** for our graduation ceremony and all seating is on a first come basis. **In order to provide a safe environment for our graduates and their families, gates at the stadium will be open at 12:00 noon. No unattended items will be permitted in the stands.**

In case of inclement weather, a decision will be made by 11:00 a.m. and the commencement ceremony will take place at 6:00 p.m. at Don Paul Stadium at Harmon Field. If the weather is still bad by 4:00 p.m., the ceremony will be moved to Monday, June 7 at 7:00 p.m. An All-Call will be sent with any time changes for commencement. Tickets will not be necessary.

Again, congratulations and thank you for supporting your child in this monumental journey. I look forward to seeing you this Sunday, June 6, 2021.
