Once again we are happy to announce that Fremont City Schools will continue to sponsor Purple and White Delights, its summer meal program available to youth 18 years old and younger. ProMedica Memorial Hospital, Terra Community College and Grace Community Church volunteers will be assisting in serving and providing activities. Meals will be served at Casa Nueva, Fremont Recreation Center and Fremont YMCA. Purple and White Delights program dates are June 11th through August 17th, with the exception of July 4th, Monday through Friday.

We are pleased to inform you that FCS will once again be implementing the Community Eligibility Program for the 2018-19 school year. This program allows all children enrolled in Fremont's Elementary Schools to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at NO cost each school day.

Summer Weekend Meal Program

The Ohio Food Bank, in partnership with the Governor's Office of Faith Based and Community Initiatives, has approved three sites for us to be able to distribute pre-packaged meals to the children in our community. The sites include Casa Nueva, Fremont Recreation Center and the Fremont YMCA. The meals are shelf stable items and each bag contains 2 breakfasts, 2 lunches and 2 dinners. Meals will be available every Friday during the duration of the program from June 15th – August 17th. During the first week of the program, applications will be sent home with each bag that is distributed. In order for children to continue to participate in the program, applications must be completed and returned to one of the three sites listed above.

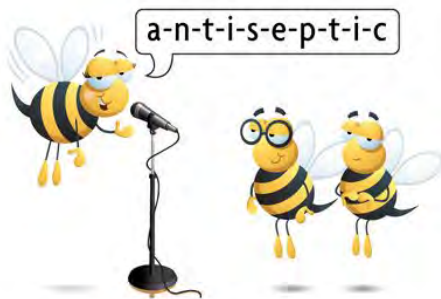

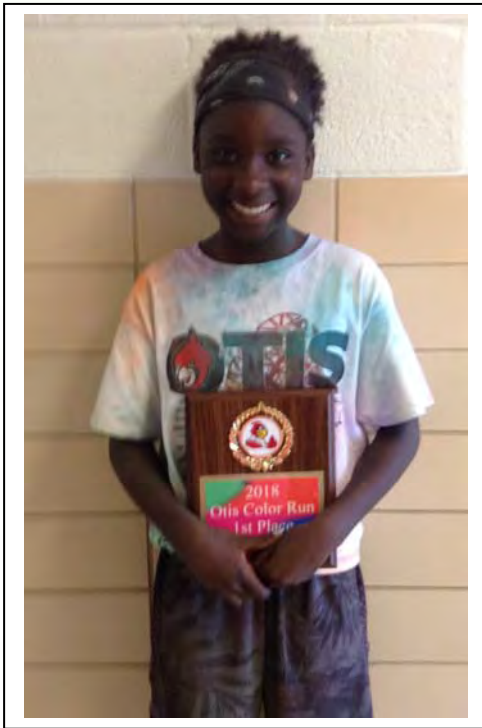
