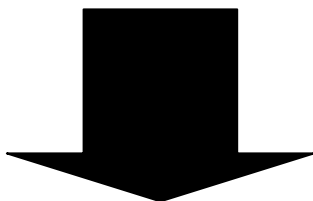

## Local Scholarship Opportunities for Seniors

**Most of these scholarships will be won by Ross Seniors!**

**Apply today!**

**AAUW Scholarship**—One girl from the top ten senior women ranked by grade point. Must plan to attend college to receive at least a bachelor's degree. Needs to be well-rounded and have a 3.5 or higher GPA. **April 21, 2010.**

**Alex Clark Minority Scholarship**—Awarded to a graduating Ross minority student. Preference given to those majoring in education, especially the sciences, but apply even if you are not entering those fields. **April 21, 2010.**

**Art Scholarships**—1)Art Department Award, 2)Dorie O'Farrel Award, 3)Eppley Award—Any Ross senior pursuing a career in art or photography is eligible. Ability, attitude, dedication, predictability of success, and financial need considered. See Mrs. Shawl for an application. **April 21, 2010.**

**Atkinson School Carol Vaffis Memorial Scholarship**—Must have attended 4 out of seven years at Atkinson Elementary School. Scholarship, financial need, and predictability of college success will be the selection criteria. **April 21, 2010.**

**Paul R. Brough Memorial Scholarship**—Must be attending Bowling Green, Tiffin, or Ohio State University. 3.0 GPA. **April 15, 2010.**

**Chamber Foundation of Sandusky County Scholarship**—One scholarship will be awarded to one high school senior from each of the ten county high schools. Must be a graduating senior, 2.5 or above GPA, reside in Sandusky County, plan to attend a two- or four-year accredited institution of high learning. **April 28, 2010.**

**Class of 1950 Scholarship**—Based on ability, attitude, dedication, and occupational or professional objectives. Any Ross senior planning to pursue higher education. **April 21, 2010.**

**Fremont Ross High School Community Honors**—Five awards given, one each for character, leadership, scholarship, service, voluntarism. No GPA requirement. **April 12, 2010**

**Croghan School Scholarship**— Must have attended Croghan School. Awarded to one boy and one girl. **April 21, 2010.**

**Don and Jane Paul Fremont Ross High School Scholarship**—Must be a graduating senior, a resident of Sandusky County, have a GPA of 3.0 or higher. One male and one female award. Based on improvement in academic record from the first year of high school to senior year, financial need, character, and leadership potential. **April 21, 2010.**

**FEA Scholarship**—This scholarship is available to the children or relatives of members of the Fremont Education Association (teachers). **April 28, 2010.**

**Hayes School Scholarship**—Given to one male and one female student who attended Hayes School at least 4 out of 7 years and plan to further their education upon graduation from high school.

**April 21, 2010.**

**Kiwanis Scholarship**—Must be a member of Key Club, plan to attend college in the fall, live in Sandusky County, be in the top 20% of graduating class, have done community service/volunteer work.

**April 19, 2010.**

**Linda S. Schwartz Scholarship**—Given to a deserving Ross student, regardless of academic standing, to further his or her education. **April 21, 2010.**

**Lutz PTO Scholarship**—For any Ross senior who attended four out of seven years at Lutz Elementary School and is planning to further his or her education upon graduation from high school. **April 12, 2010.**

**Lutz Staff Scholarship**—For a graduating Ross Senior who spent four out of seven years at Lutz. Scholarship, financial need, and predictability of success are the criteria for selection. **April 12, 2010.**

**Lutz William Krumnow Scholarship**-- For a graduating Ross Senior who spent four out of seven years at Lutz. Scholarship, financial need, and predictability of success are the criteria for selection.

**NAACP Scholarship and Heidelberg Scholarship**— Ross High Senior; 2.5 G.P.A.; have participated in multicultural activities; community service; have parent or guardian who is a member in good standing of Fremont Branch of NAACP. **May 15, 2010.**

**Ohio Association of Public School Employees Local #321**—For any graduating senior whose parent/guardian is a member in good standing with OAPSE and is employed by the Fremont City Schools. Based on academic standing, financial need, character. Must be used for training beyond high school.

**April 21, 2010.**

**Otis Elementary School Scholarship**—Must have attended Otis. Based on academics, financial need, predictability of success in college. **April 27, 2010.**

**The Jean and H.W. "Bill" Rhodes Scholarship**—Given to a worthy Ross student who will be attending college. Based on character, scholarship, financial need. **April 21, 2010.**

**Ross High School Scholarship**—Any Ross senior planning to further his or her education. Scholarship, financial need, and predictability of success are criteria. **April 6, 2010.**

**Stamm PTO Scholarship**-- Stamm Elementary School PTO has established a scholarship for graduating Ross seniors who attended at least four years at Stamm. Academic potential, character, and extracurricular activities will be considered in the selection process. **March 31, 2010.**

**Washington School Scholarship**—Must have attended Washington School for four years and be accepted at an accredited college or nursing school. Based on academic potential, character, and extracurricular activities. **April 9, 2010.**

**Women of the Moose Fremont Chapter #624 Nursing Scholarship**—Applicant must be a graduating senior from a Fremont high school with a minimum 2.0 GPA. Student must be planning a career in nursing.
