- L. To prepare for, conduct, and/or review negotiations or bargaining sessions with public employees concerning their compensation or other terms and conditions of their employment.

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- M. To consider matters required to be kept confidential by federal law or regulations or state statutes.
- N. To discuss details relative to the security arrangements and emergency response protocols for the Board.
- O. To discuss confidential information related to an application for economic development assistance, or negotiations with other political subdivisions related to the application, as executive session is necessary to protect interests of the applicant or related expenditure of public funds. (Unanimous vote required.)

B. OTHER MATTERS

ITEM 1. Consider approving GMP Amendments 4.1 and 5.1 to the CMR Agreement with Gilbane Building Company

The Superintendent recommends approval of GMP Amendments 4.1 Lutz and 5.1 Otis to the CMR Agreement with Gilbane Building Company for the early site package work for the new Otis and Lutz Elementary School buildings and requests authority to have the amendments signed.

ITEM 1. Consider approving GMP Amendments 4.1 and 5.1 to the CMR Agreement with Gilbane Building Company (cont.)

Background Information:

- 1. The Fremont City School District Board of Education (Board) previously approved an agreement with Gilbane Building Company (CMR) as the construction manager at risk, which specifically addressed pre-construction stage services required for the co-funded Classroom Facilities Assistance Program (CFAP) project, which includes five (5) new elementary schools and a new high school.
- 2. Based upon schematic design stage drawings, specifications, and other information prepared for the new Otis and Lutz Elementary School buildings (Project) by SSOE Group, the Board's A/E for the elementary schools included in the CFAP project, the CMR prepared a guaranteed maximum price (GMP) proposal for the Early Site Package and GMP Amendments 4.1 and 5.1, including supporting documentation and exhibits, all of which has been reviewed by the Core Team.
- 3. The CMR has modified the GMP Amendments 4.1 and 5.1 documents based upon comments from the OFCC Project Manager and will continue to make adjustments based upon additional OFCC review and comments received.
- 4. The GMP amendments presented for approval, subject to approval by the OFCC, are:
 - a. GMP Amendment 4.1– Early site package work for the new Lutz Elementary School building in the GMP amount of \$548,746, all of which is co-funded work.
 - b. GMP Amendment 5.1– Early site package work for the new Otis Elementary School building in the GMP amount of \$889,944, all of which is co-funded work.

The Fremont City School District Board of Education resolves as follows:

- 1. The GMP Amendments No. 4.1 and 5.1 to the CMR Agreement with Gilbane Building Company for the early site package work for the new Otis and Lutz Elementary School buildings are approved in the total amount of \$1,438,690, all of which is co-funded work, subject to final approval by the OFCC, which will increase the total Contract Sum for the CMR Agreement by this amount.
- 2. The Board President, Superintendent, and Treasurer are authorized to sign GMP Amendments 4.1 and 5.1 in the final version, after review and approval by OFCC, and any related documents required for the early site work at these two elementary school building sites.
