- The first day of school for students in Grades 10-12 is Wednesday, August 27 (9th graders also attend)

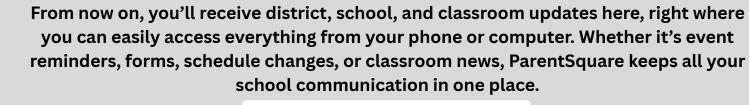
The school day for Ross High will remain 7:30 a.m. - 2:30 p.m.

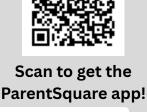




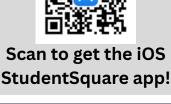

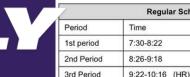
