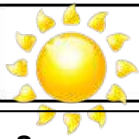

### **Student Dress Code -**

There are no changes to the Student Dress Code Policy for the upcoming school year.

### **Electronics/Cell Phone Policy –**

There are no changes to the electronics policy and it will be strictly enforced.

### **Food Service –**

Students will need to have funds in their student meal account in order to purchase meals. Parents may access student meal accounts to add funds and apply for free or reduced meals through this site: <https://fremontcity.familyportal.cloud/>. Cash or check payments to student meal accounts may be made at the cafeteria register during the breakfast periods only at both FMS and Ross HS. Any payment made outside of this time period must be made in the school office. There will be no change given at the register.

### **Immunizations –**

The 2023-2024 immunization information can be found on our website by selecting the “Parent/Student Information” tab on the left side of the home page and then selecting one of the Immunization tabs.

### **Student Identification Badges:**

Students in grades 9-12 must show their student identification badges in order to attend home football games and school dances. Additionally, students eligible for drug testing must have their identification badges prior to testing. Students will receive their ID

during the 1<sup>st</sup> week of school. Students new to FCS may get their ID photos taken on August 31– School Photo Day.

### IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS!

### ATTENTION - Immunization Requirement for 12<sup>th</sup> Grade



#### Parents and Guardians of Juniors –

Ohio law requires students entering 12<sup>th</sup> grade be vaccinated against meningococcal disease. The students are required to have MCV4 immunization prior to the first day of 12<sup>th</sup> grade.

Please contact the Sandusky County Health Department at 419-334-6367 or your family physician to schedule an appointment.

Students not in compliance with the immunization requirements are to be excluded from school attendance no later than the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the school year.

If you have questions, please contact the nurse, Nichole Mendoza, R.N. at 419-334-5469, or by email at [mendozan@fremontschools.net](mailto:mendozan@fremontschools.net). Please provide documentation to the nurse as soon as possible after your student receives the required immunization. Additional information can be found at the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) website or by calling the Sandusky County Dept of Health.

**Summer Program**

Fremont Ross High School will be an open meal site where any guardian may pick up a meal package on Mondays from 11:30 AM - 1:00 PM for any child in their household. The meal distribution will run from June 12 through Aug 18, 2023. FCS will be closed on Monday June 19th so distribution will be held on Tues June 20th of that week. Meal packages will include 5 days of breakfast and 5 days of lunch in accordance with USDA's SFSP K-12 meal pattern. Pickup will be held as a drive through line in the bus turn around behind the school.

Parents should enter the line through the right side of the circle by turning right from Cedar Street behind Fremont Middle School and making their way through the turn around where the meals will be distributed, then turn right to exit the line. Signs will be posted and there will be staff directing traffic.

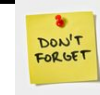
**2023-2024 School Meals**
